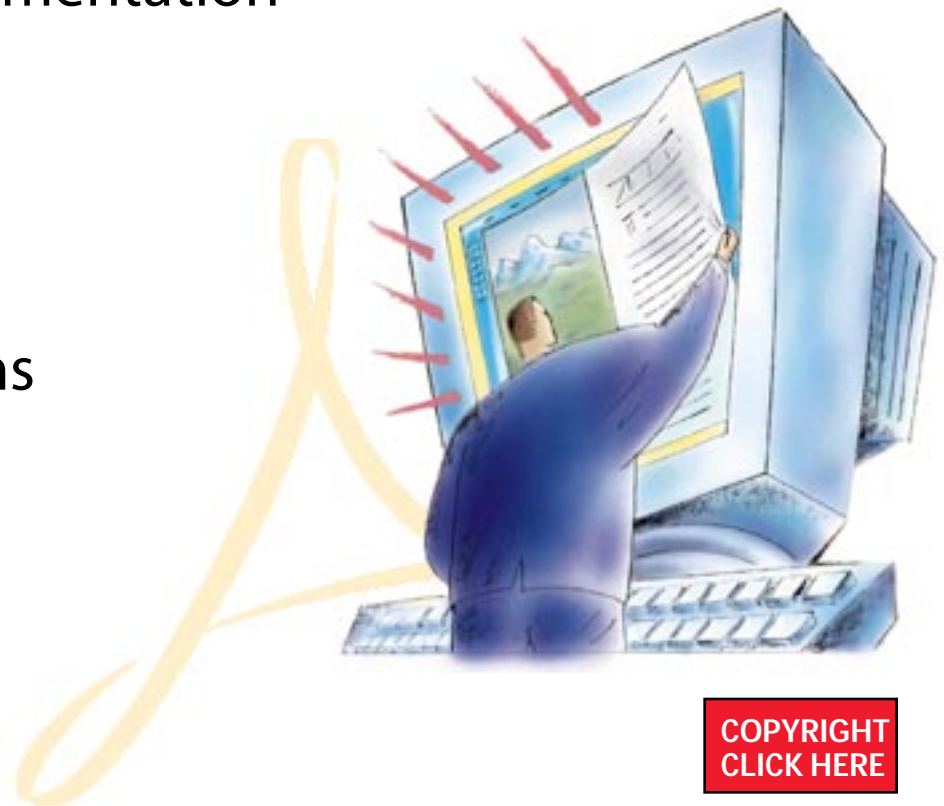

Navigational tools have been built into this guide to help you find the information you need:

The Main button ( Main) in the lower right of each page always returns you to the first page of this guide. You can also use the same button in the Acrobat menu.

The Previous button ( Previous) returns you to the previous page, which is generally a top-level menu.

To return to the previous menu after opening the technical document files on the CD, simply use the close box at the upper left of your screen. This will close the document you are in and return you to the tour. You can also use the Go Back button () in the Acrobat menu. This will leave your document open on the desktop and return you to the tour.
