



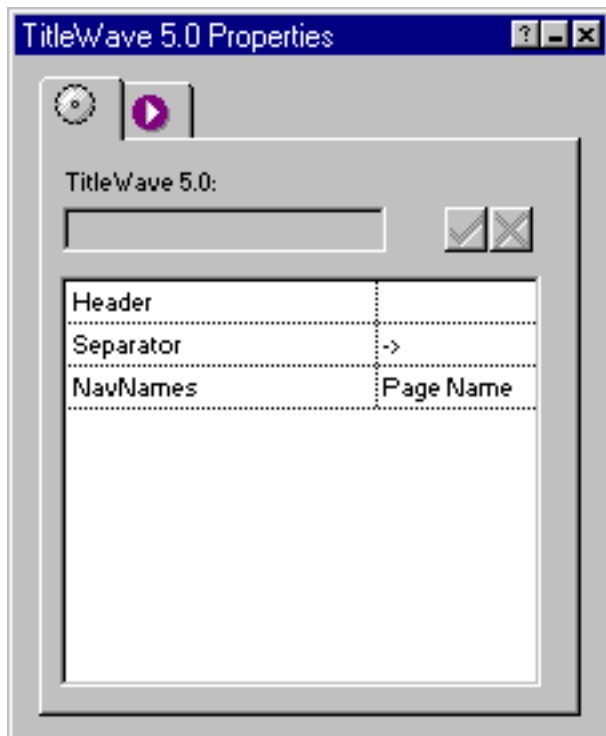
# TitleWave 5.0

## Getting Started

TitleWave saves you the tedious task of inserting custom 'path' titles for each page in Fusion 4.0/5.0. The title bars on each page of the club site are a good example of what the TitleWave can generate automatically!

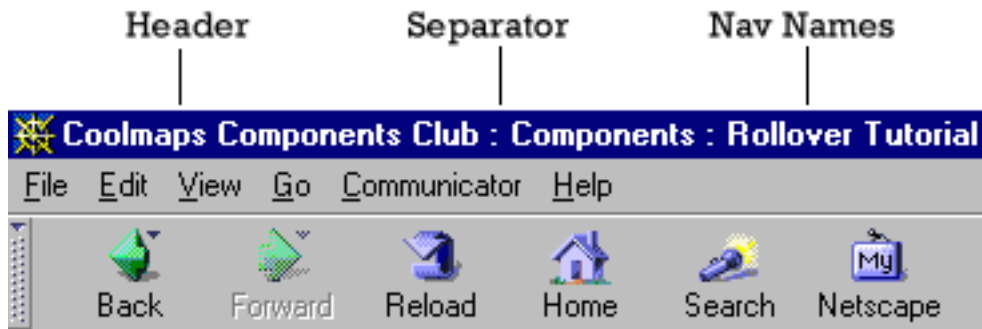
- Run the Installation program, specifying the location of Fusion 4.0/5.0's component directory.
- Launch Fusion
- If the coolmaps.com component toolbar is not visible choose View > Toolbars > Component Tools > coolmaps.com components
- Select the TitleWave component and drag out an area on the page (this graphic does not appear on the published page).

The TitleWave properties now appears in Fusion's properties palette.

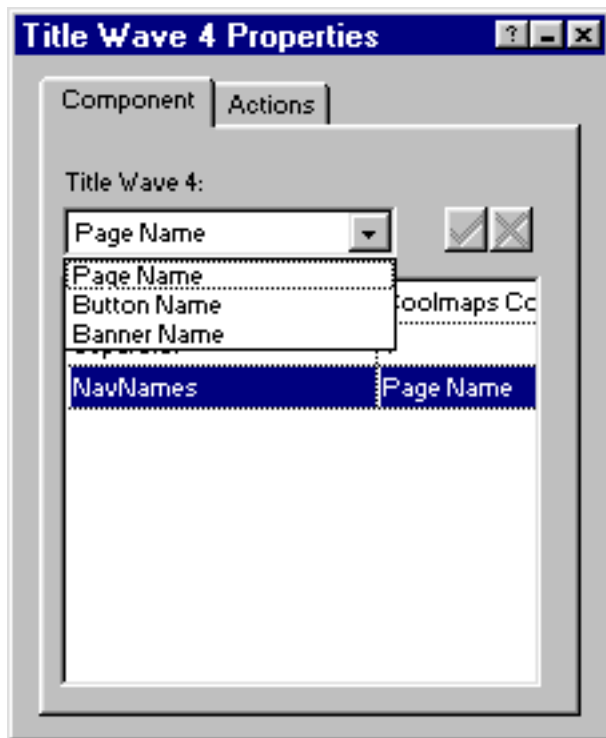


## Creating a TitleWave

When TitleWave is placed in a masterborder it will generate custom 'path' titles for each page, depending on the options you have selected.



The below options were used to create the above title bar. Remember that this is applied across all pages using that MasterBorder.



## Points to Remember

Using the TitleWave is easy but there are a few points to remember:

- You will need to place a TitleWave component in each MasterBorder your site uses.
- If placed in a layout region the TitleWave will only produce a custom title for that page
- TitleWave draws on Fusion's Custom Names. You can define your own Page, Button and Banner names in

Fusion by accessing Custom Names (Edit > Custom Names).

- The structure of your site tree is important. TitleWave reflects this.
