

USING MODEL I/III DISK LOAD80

Check the accompanying articles in 80 MICRO for instructions on using each program. All systems compatible with the program are listed in the Keybox. The RELOAD 80 column also contains information on using LOAD 80. For back issues of 80 MICRO or LOAD 80, call (800)-258-5473.

New Disk Transfer System: Load 80 disks boot on both the Model I and III. To use the new disks; transfer their files to your TRSDOS system or data disk as follows:

- 1.) Back up a TRSDOS disk and purge it of any old visible files.
- 2.) Insert the Load 80 in drive zero of your Model I or III.
- 3.) Press the reset button.

- *Two-drive users: Insert your TRSDOS disk in drive 1. This is the destination disk and drive.
- *Single-drive users: When the computer prompts for the destination drive, press the zero key.
