 using the United Parcel Service 2nd Day Blue Label service for second day
 delivery to your store. Remember, however, that one day is necessary to
 process your order.

MULTIPLAN - USING AVERAGE AND SORT FUNCTIONS

In Multiplan there is a problem in using the Average and Sort functions when there are blank cells referenced in the average formula. If the first cell referenced is a blank cell, once a sort has been performed, the first cell is no longer referenced by the average formula regardless of the contents of that cell. The way to avoid the problem is to use the Name function and name the cells you wish to average. Thus, even after a sort has been performed, the Average (name) formula is referencing the same cells.

This problem and solution were tested on the Model 4 and Tandy 2000 versions of Multiplan (26-1530 & 26-5311).

<u>TANDY 200 (26-3860) - MULTIPLAN WORKSHEET PROBLEM</u>

If the Tandy 200's nicad batteries are low when you exit a Multiplan worksheet sometimes you can not access that worksheet again. Depending on how many other files you have in that bank at the time you are trying to access the worksheet you will receive either:

INSUFFICIENT FREE SPACE

if there is too much memory in use for the file to be opened according to the "files requirements", or

BAD FILE FORMAT

when there is enough free memory.

If the batteries are very low and there is NO external power supply attached, then when you bring the system back up after being shut down in a worksheet it will return to the system menu and the worksheet will probably be "zapped".

Symptoms of a worksheet having been zapped are:

File size changing greatly (larger or smaller)
Sum of Free memory and all of the file sizes is less then 19K

The information on page 50 of the Owner's Manual DOES say that when the low power light comes on the unit should be immediately turned off and the batteries replaced. A user should not be using the unit after this light comes on. Otherwise you will lose the file you are working with.

Another potential low battery problem we discovered is that if the computer is turned on with low enough power, it cannot be turned off using the power switch. Attachment of a power supply or replacement of the batteries will enable the unit to be turned off. (We have not let the system sit to see if the auto power off feature would turn it off or not.)



NEW MODEL 4/4P TECHNICAL REFERENCE MANUAL (26-2119)

The Model 4 Technical Reference Manual (26-2110) has been discontinued. The manual is being re-written combining Model 4 and 4P information. The printing is complete on this manual and it is available from TEW under the stock number 26-2119.

PROFILE 4 PLUS (26-1635, 01.00.00) - WITH THE "LS-UTILITY DISK"

There is hope for Profile 4 Plus users who have discovered they cannot pass keystrokes through a JCL file in order to fully automate the program. Logical Systems Inc. sells a product called the LS-Utility Disk (not to be confused with our own TRSDOS 6.2 Utilities Disk 26-0315). The disk contains the same TYPEIN/CMD utility which solved this problem when using Profile III Plus HD.

NOTE: Since this LS-Utility Disk has not been tested by us, we can make no guarantees. Canadian Support, however, has had several customers report using it with success. The package number is L-32-150; and costs \$49.00. Logical Systems' toll free order line is (800)248-3535. Call (414)355-5454 for information and technical support.

SCRIPSIT 2.1 AND 3.0 (26-4531 & 26-4835) - MERGING DOCUMENTS

when merging with a base document which contains a blank page, the message "variable contains too many characters" (2.x) or "variable not found" (3.x) appears when merging the first variable group.

To correct this problem simply add a blank line <ENTER> to the blank page or delete the page that is blank.

XENIX - CALCULATING BLOCKS

The following formula may be used to calculate the number of blocks on a secondary hard disk when making a Xenix file system:

(# of heads x # of cylinders x 17) - 442 = # of blocks

This formula for calculating block sizes on Xenix systems is not always correct. While it is good for the 8 through 15 meg drives it is incorrect for 35 and 70 meg drives under 3.0 Xenix. The new release of Xenix allows for 96 bad tracks if the drive has over 3000 tracks. This reduces the number of tracks that are available for your use. To handle the additional bad track allocation, you should subtract an additional 1224 blocks from the number derived from the above formula. Later versions of 1.3.x may act this way also.

An easy way to check how many bad tracks diskutil has allowed for is to use the diskstat program. One of the drive parameters that it reports is the maximum number of bad tracks. Currently this program is only on 3.0 Xenix; however, you may restore it onto a 1.3.x system and it will work fine.

MODEL 16 PAYROLL (26-6203, 03.00.00) - CONTROL FILE MAINTENANCE

There is a problem in Payroll in the Control File Maintenance section. When three digits past the decimal are entered in field 19 (special pay factor) the program will accept all three, but when the screen is exited and returned to, the last digit is truncated (i.e. .071 = .070). The manual (page 4.3.5) states that it will hold three decimal places. In answer to SPR \$6203-76 this problem will be corrected in the next release of Xenix Payroll. Only two decimal will be accepted. The addendum will reflect the manual correction for both overtime rate and special rate.

<u>TANDY 1200 HD - ASSIGNING DRIVES</u>

It has come to my attention that when some software companies convert their MS-DOS software packages from floppy drive systems to hard drive systems, they use the "ASSIGN" command to reassign drive designations instead of offering a setup menu for machine type. This method, although effective, can cause a world of problems if the Tandy 1200 HD drives are not reassigned to their normal values upon exiting the program.

CASE IN POINT:

- 1 Customer runs the software which reassigns drive specifications.
- 2. Exits program normally (with drives still reassigned).
- Customer then begins to format a disk in what he thinks is still drive A: and promptly blows away his hard disk (true story).

SOLUTION TO PROBLEM:

- 1. Create a batch file which calls the said software package.
- 2. On the first line of the batch file, place the commands to execute that program.
- 3. On the second line of the batch file, place the MS-DOS command "ASSIGN", which will reset the drive specifications to their default values.

Now when you execute the batch file, the software package will run, but when you exit the package, the ASSIGN command will reset the drives to their default values.

TANDY 1000 - SOFTWARE GENERATED SCREEN DUMP

The following BASIC program was taken from a book called "Inside the IBM" by Peter Norton. Using it we were able to produce a software generated screen dump on the Tandy 1000. Lines 10-50 are used to set up and poke into memory the opcodes of the assembly program that performs the screen dump, these lines can be inserted at the beginning of your BASIC program. Line 60 makes the actual call, and can be used directly as shown or as a result of an 'if' statement.

HOME ACCOUNTANT PLUS (26-5340, 01.01.00) - WITH DAISY WHEEL II & LINE PRINTERS

On page 2 of the Home Accountant Addendum is a list of printers not supported with the original version of Home Accountant Plus. The following procedure should enable you to use this program with the unsupported printers.

Put MS-DOS 02.11.01 or 02.11.02 onto a backup of your Home Accountant then create config.sys.

At the a> prompt type:

Edlin config.sys <ENTER>
*i <ENTER>

- 2: device = LPDRVR.SYS <ENTER>
- 3: <CONTROL> C

NOTE: The * in the lines above is the prompt in edlin. Do not type it in.
