The following information is provided by Technical Support, Computer Customer Service, and Computer Merchandising.

#### COLOR COMPUTER C-COMPILER (26-3038) - CATALOG REQUIREMENTS INCORRECT

The hardware requirements for the Color Computer C-Compiler, as described on page 60 of RSC-16, are incorrect. This package requires 2 disk drives to run.

# MODEL 4 SUPERSCRIPSIT (26-1595) - NO UPGRADE TO SCRIPSIT PRO (26-1601) PLANNED

There are no plans to offer an upgrade from Model 4 SuperSCRIPSIT to SCRIPSIT Pro. A new version (01.02.00) of SuperSCRIPSIT is in the works but is at least six to eight months down the road.

### RM COBOL (90-0470) - CATALOG DESCRIPTION ERROR

In RSC-16 (page 61) stock number 90-0470 for RM COBOL is described as: the Tandy 3000 Development System. This product is not an MS-DOS COBOL Development System program. It should read:

#### Tandy 3000 XENIX COBOL Development System

Please be sure to correct this in your catalog.

NOTE: The Tandy 3000 Xenix Operating System is currently not available.

#### AUTOCAD PROGRAMS (90-0362, 90-0363, 90-0364, 90-0416) - ERROR IN CATALOG

Page 45 in the RSC-16 catalog indicates that the AutoCAD programs: AutoCAD, Advanced Drafting Extension-2, Advanced Drafting Extension-3, AE/CADD are supported on all of Tandy's MS-DOS computers. This is incorrect. AutoCAD is currently not supported on the Tandy 3000. The vendor is in the process of testing these programs on the Tandy 3000. We will notify you when there is a change in the support situation.

### TANDY 1000 MICRO ILLUSTRATOR (25-1120, 01.00.00) - CURSOR INSTABILITY

Numerous Tandy 1000 users have commented on the instability of the cursor both at rest and during movement in Micro Illustrator. Upon further investigation, it was found that this was due to hardware limitations. The D --> A Converter puts out 290 values but the cursor requires 320 values; therefore, the cursor appears unstable.

#### TANDY 1000/2000 SCRIPSIT (25-1155) - CORRECT NAME FOR USER KEY EDITING COMMAND

In the SCRIPSIT 1000/2000 manual under the User Keys section, there is a reference to the KEY STOP (ALT-F7) command. This command temporarily stops the execution of a user key. The KEY STOP command is also referenced in the "Customizing SCRIPSIT" section, but is referred to as "KEYPAUSE". When editing a User Key, the command is displayed as KEYPAUSE. KEYPAUSE is the correct name for the command.

# TANDY 1000/1200 - PROBLEMS PRINTING FROM WORKSHEETS

If you are having problems printing more than 80 characters per line from a worksheet (e.g., Multiplan, Lotus, PFS:Plan), even if you specified 132 characters, check your config.sys file. If the line:

driver - LPDRVR.SYS

is in the config.sys file, remove the line to print more than 80 characters per line.

When running Flight Simulator on a Tandy 1200 HD, the ground will be gray, instead of green, because the color green was not written into the color definitions in Flight Simulator for the Tandy 1200 HD.

# TANDY 3000 (25-4001) - RUNNING MICROPRO'S CORRECTSTAR

When attempting to run MicroPro's CorrectStar on a Tandy 3000, you may get the error message:

"INTERNAL DICTIONARY NOT FOUND"

Apply the following patch to correct this error:

1. Enter DEBUG with the following prompt:

DEBUG CORRSTAR.OVR

2. Once within DEBUG, load the file into memory by typing:

1 <ENTER>

- 3. Type E1342 <ENTER>. This should display the value 75.
- Enter the value <u>7C</u>, and press <u>⟨ENTER⟩</u>.
- 5. Type W <ENTER> and DEBUG will write the patched file back to the hard drive.
- 6. Type Q <ENTER> to exit DEBUG.

EDITOR'S NOTE: This patch was provided by MicroPro's Technical Support Department. They did not specify if this patch was for CorrectStar as a separate package or the CorrectStar portion of Wordstar Professional (25-3170). See UPDATE 1986-04 for a procedure to install the Wordstar Professional dictionary for use with the Tandy 3000.
