SCRIPSIT PATCHES

NEVER PATCH YOUR ORIGINAL DISKETTE. APPLY PATCHES TO YOUR MASTER DISKETTE, AND THEN MAKE BACKUPS OF IT FOR YOUR WORKING COPIES.

ALL PATCHES ARE FROM TANDY AND ARE MANDATORY FOR PROPER OPERATION.

(APPLICABLE TO SCRIPSIT 2.0 ONLY)

There are four Do Files on the SCRPATCH diskette.

PATCH1 Contains the first 80 patches released by Tandy. When completed it will run PATCH2.

- PATCH2 Contains 30 patches. These should only be applied if your startup screen date is 06/09/82. If your date is before that start with PATCH1.
- PATCH3 Applies only if you are using the dictionary feature. These patches must be applied to your master diskette AFTER the dictionary has been installed.
- PATCH4 Applies only if you are using the dictionary feature. This patch must be applied to your master Spelling and hyphenation diskette.

 HOW TO INSTALL THE PATCHES

The PATCH Files are distributed on a data diskette. If you have more than one drive, place your SCRIPSITTM diskette to be patched on drive 0 and the SCRPATCH diskette on any other available drive.

End the SCRIPSIT™ session if you were using SCRIPSIT™, and type at TRSDOS Ready

DO PATCHx (x=appropriate patch number 1-4) and press <ENTER>

The purpose of each patch may be obtained from copies of 'TRS-80 Microcomputer News' a Tandy publication.

If a patch has already been applied, the screen will indicate PATCH ABORTED. Processing will continue to the next patch. As each patch is applied, you will be notified PATCH COMPLETE.

There are a total of 115 patches in the files. It would be best to patch your master (NOT ORIGINAL) copy of SCRIPSIT and then make backups of it as needed.

If you have only one drive, ask your friendly Radio Shack dealer to copy the SCRPATCH disk onto your SCRIPSITM diskette(s) for you. Then follow the instructions as outlined above.
